The Mega Jackpot is a progressive jackpot system, which combines slot machines from six Casinos Poland casinos into one network, enabling an even more exciting game with much bigger payoffs during simultaneous games.

Via the progressive jackpot system, a part of every bet made on slot machines connected to the network is accumulated into a common pool. Mega Jackpot players actually can see the prize increasing as they play.

Slot machines at the following casinos of Casinos Poland have been connected to the Mega Jackpot system: the Casino in the Marriott Hotel in Warsaw, the Casino in the Hyatt Hotel in Warsaw, the Casino in the Hotel HP Park Plaza in Wroclaw, the Casino in the Novotel Bronowice Hotel in Krakow, the Casino in the Hotel Polonez in Poznan and the Casino in the Altus building in Katowice.

The successful launch of the new jackpot system was accompanied by special events and promotions with attractions in each individual casino.
