JOB SUMMARY

Responsible for keeping the grounds and backside barn stall area maintained with a clean, neat, and orderly appearance.

JOB REQUIREMENTS

Handling supplies for plants and equipment to maintain the grounds.

- Responsible for cutting, weeding, and edging the grass, raking the leaves, and sweeping the parking lots, and garage.
- Responsible for planting, removing, and relocating plants, flowers, trees, and bushes.
- Removing all trash and debris from parking lot areas and grounds. Emptying trash containers.
- Responsible for ensuring all signs, posts, chain fences are straight and secure.
- Operate large equipment to include large tractors, vacuum machines and loaders.
- Ensure the safety and security of all guests and employees, by keeping roads and walkways clean of debris, snow, ice or any other obstructions.
- All other duties as assigned.

Ability to read, write, and understand simple instructions. Ability to use all necessary tools and equipment to perform maintenance functions. Answer all calls promptly and maintain politeness; pay attention to the needs of employees and guests at all times. Knowledge of OSHA required standards and safety requirements.
