

## HVAC TECHNICIAN

### JOB SUMMARY:

Candidate is responsible for installation of all heating, air conditioning, cooking and refrigerator equipment. Candidate is also responsible for the repairs of all heating, air conditioning, cooking and refrigerator units. The Candidate will repair and clean refrigeration equipment including compressors, evaporators, condensers, and controls. Candidate will be required to quickly assess, troubleshoot, and repair electrical and mechanical problems affecting operations with minimal supervision. The candidate will regularly be exposed to the risk of electric shock and will be required to follow all safety rules. The candidate will be occasionally exposed to wet and/or humid conditions, extreme cold, extreme heat, and noise. Candidate will also be responsible to assist the Kitchen technicians as required. Candidate will be required to have and maintain a universal HVAC certification; the candidate will be responsible for record keeping and maintaining a supply of critical spare parts. Candidate will be responsible for all other duties assigned by Management. Must be physically able to lift, bend, stoop, climb, and reach with or without reasonable accommodation. Candidate must have and retain a valid driver's license. Candidate must be able to work flexible hours including weekends, all shifts, and holidays. Candidate is required to be able to obtain/maintain a West Virginia Racing License

### JOB REQUIREMENTS:

Must be able to stand walk sit for extended periods. May be exposed to working in a noisy, smoke secondary smoke environment.

Must be at least 21. Must be able to obtain and maintain appropriate licensing. Must be able to pass a background investigation.

### EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

High School diploma or equivalent. Trade school is a plus but not required. EPA Certification required. Min Class II Requirement.
