(4) BOUND TO BE SMART has done little wrong in her young career. After a runner-up finish in her first ever start, she again did all the grunt work up front in her next start on Fall Classic day back on September 6 in the Sturgeon River Stake, only to get caught late again going six furlongs. She must tangle with the boys again but will appreciate the class drop and cutback in distance in here. The two-year-old daughter of Flat Out retains leading jockey Rico Walcott in the irons to call the shots for the Jerri Robertson barn. Walcott continued his hot streak last Sunday visiting the winners circle 5 times.

Keep an eye on (1) DOUGS PAL who showed improvement in his latest effort with the addition of blinkers and (6) DARK INVADER a nicely bred sort from the Grieves barn sired by STREET BOSS who had a superb lifetime record of 13-7-3-1 banking \$831,800 in lifetime earnings. Both of these appear to be top threats in this contest.

The key to ensuring a successful profit at the races requires selecting the right spots on a daily basis. This analysis has been designed to help both novice and experienced players select that one special horse deemed to be the best wager of any horse running that day. The Play of the Day will be available for every live racing card at Century Mile.
