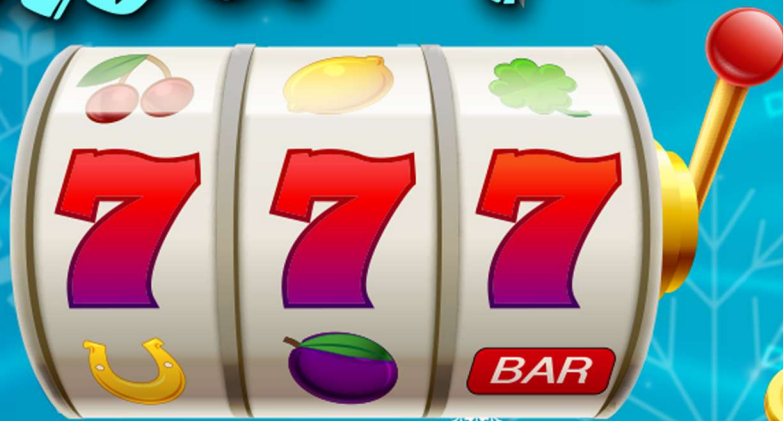


# Power Play



## SLOT TOURNAMENTS!

### RULES AND REGULATIONS

**PROMOTION PERIOD:** Thursdays from February 6, 2025 to March 27, 2025

- Century Mile Racetrack and Casino and their decisions are final, binding and conclusive. Century Mile Racetrack and Casino reserves the right to revise, change or cancel any promotion at any time without notice.
- Century Mile Racetrack and Casino cannot be held liable for any errors or negligence that may arise or occur in connection with any promotion. Century Mile Racetrack and Casino is not liable for accidents or injuries from use of promotional items.
- Employees of Century Mile Racetrack and Casino are not eligible to enter or win any contests or promotions.
- Prizes must be accepted as awarded and are not transferable. Cash cannot be taken in lieu of prizes.

### ELIGIBILITY

- Participants must be 18 years of age or older.
- Century Mile Racetrack and Casino is the sole judge of entrant eligibility.
- Patrons currently deemed ineligible by AGLC and patrons currently banned from Century Mile Racetrack and Casino are not eligible to win promotional draws and prizes.
- Winner must present valid government issued photo identification to claim any winnings.
- Participants are only eligible to play once, excluding the finale.

### REGISTRATION

- Slot tournaments are free to enter and participate in.
- Registration will open the day of the tournament at Guest Services and close 10 minutes prior to the listed start time.
- Registration is on a first come, first served basis. Tournament rounds will be assigned in order of registration.

### TOURNAMENT STRUCTURE

- Tournaments take place every Thursday in February and March beginning at 7:00pm.
- Each tournament will consist of as many sessions as there are registered players.
- Each session will be two minutes in length, with up to eight players maximum per session.
- Sessions will be run back-to-back with no scheduled breaks in between.
- The top eight scores overall will advance to the finale.
- All scores will be calculated by the tournament machine software.

### PRIZE STRUCTURE

- Session winners will receive a \$25 slot voucher.
- The top eight scores overall will advance to the finale, where the prizing will be as follows: First Place: \$1000; Second Place: \$750; Third Place: \$500; Fourth Place: \$250; Fifth Place: \$200; Sixth Place: \$150; Seventh Place: \$100; Eighth Place: \$50

### MACHINE MALFUNCTIONS

- If a machine malfunctions during a regular session, the player affected will be moved into the next available round.
- If a machine malfunctions more than once in a tournament, it will be removed from tournament play and the number of players per round will be reduced.
- Should the number of playable tournament machines be reduced, the finale will be split into two rounds of four to ensure all top eight qualifying players will get a chance to play.
- Players may be bumped from the round they signed up in if the number of machines has been reduced. They will be placed into the next available round.
- Should a machine malfunction in the finale, the player on the malfunctioning machine will get another chance to play following the completion of the round. Once that player completes a full two-minute final round, the score will be added to the rest of the finale scores and respective prizing will be awarded.

### GENERAL RULES

- Players are only permitted to play once per tournament, excluding the finale.
- Players must only play under their own name and are not permitted to play under any alternate names, or in the place of another registered player.
- Players must present Government Issued Photo Identification to claim any winnings. Identification must match the respective name played. If a participant is found playing under another participant's name, they will be disqualified and forfeit any prize money.
- It is the players responsibility to remain in the tournament area to ensure they hear any and all announcements made by Tournament Staff.
- Should a player miss their scheduled round, the round will proceed without them. They will have until the start of the final regular session to notify Tournament Staff and complete their round.
- The top eight players will have two minutes to find their seats for the final round. Should a player in the final round be absent after two minutes, a final announcement will be made over the in-house PA system and another two minutes will be allotted. If a player is missing from the final round, they will forfeit their turn, and the 9th highest score will be substituted into the finale.
